

Crosshatch Cowl

Yarn: 1 skein Malabrigo Merino
Worsted – Azul Bolita
Hook: H (5.00mm)
Accessories: Oblong or large button
Gauge:
21 st x 7 rows = 4”
- using the stitch pattern below.

I designed this cowl with the help of
“101 Crochet Stitches” book from
Interweave Press.

I was on the lookout for a simple and
quick pattern to use, but could not
find one to suite my taste. . . thus, the
Crosshatch Cowl was born!



Pattern

- Ch. 91 (this includes the turning chain)

Row 1:

Skip 2 ch (counts as first dc), 2 dc into next ch,
*skip 3 ch, 1 sc into next ch, ch 3, 1 dc into each of next 3 ch;
Repeat from * to last 4 ch, skip 3 ch, 1 sc into last ch, turn.

Row 2:

Ch 3 (counts as first dc), 2 dc into first sc,
*skip 3 dc, 1 sc into first of 3ch, ch3, 1 dc into next 2ch, 1 dc into next sc;
Repeat from * until last 3 stitches – then skip 2 dc, 1 sc into top of the
turning ch, turn.

Rows 3 – end:

Repeat row 2.

(The cowl shown below was done in 10 rows).

- When you get to the last stitch of your final row, work the sc as usual, and then fasten off.

This cowl looks great in both positions featured below!
