

Rugged Ripples



Materials:

- multiple colors of Cascade 220, or another worsted weight yarn.
- 5.5mm (US I) hook
- tapestry needle

Gauge: Not too tight, not too loose!

Measurements:

55 x 60" (or until desired length is achieved)

Notes:

- dc2tog: *yo, insert hook into next stitch, yo, pull through once, yo, pull through two loops (two loops left remaining)*
 - repeat from * to * then: yo, pull through three remaining loops.
 - Decrease accomplished.

- blo: back loop only

- Using Cascade 220: 48 yards (144 ft) is used for each color.

Pattern:

Ch 183 (includes turning chain)

Row 1:

Skip 3ch (counts as 1dc); 1dc in next chain

* 1dc into each of the next 3ch, [work dc2tog over next 2ch] twice;

1dc into each of the next 3ch, [2dc in next ch] twice*

Repeat from * to * ending the last repetition with 2dc in last ch; turn.

Row 2:

(work blo)

3ch (counts as 1dc); 1dc into very first stitch

* 1dc into each of the next 3 sts, [work dc2tog over next 2 sts] twice;

1dc into each of the next 3 sts, [2dc in next st] twice*

Repeat from * to * of row 2 only, ending the last repetition with 2dc in last st; turn.

Row 3 & up:

Repeat row 2

Each color is 2 rows
